CITY OF DURAND ORDINANCE NO. 2019-12-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF DURAND, MICHIGAN BY ADDING SECTIONS 74-106 TO 74-11 OF ARTICLE II DIVISION 3 CHAPTER 74, AND DEFINE SPECIFIC PROVISIONS WITHIN THE CODE TO BE MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTIONS. SHORT TITLE; PURPOSES; AMENDMENTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DURAND ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Short Title. This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Durand Union Station Overnight Parking Ordinance."

<u>Public Purpose.</u> The City Council of the City of Durand does hereby deem it to be in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Durand to hereby establish certain individual ordinances of the City to be amended so as to establish an overnight parking zone on the city owned Durand Union Station.

Amendments:

Section 74-106 - Establishment of restricted zones – Durand Union Station.

Zones to be known as parking meter zones may be established by traffic control orders issued as provided in the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships and Villages, as adopted in Section 74-10, on any street or City operated off-street parking area. This ordinance establishes a parking zone at Durand Union Station, a city owned property located at 200 S Railroad Street for overnight parking.

Section 74-107 - Installation and operation.

Multi-space (pay station) parking meters installed centrally within streets or surface lots. Each parking space shall be identified by a stall number. Each parking meter shall indicate by proper legend the currency or accepted credit card types to be deposited and the time limitations for each payment method deposited. Virtual account payments will reflect date and paid duration in the account. Upon the expiration of the time limit for payments made at the meter, the printed receipt will indicate that the lawful parking period has expired. In the case of an expired parking period, the right of the motor vehicle to occupy such a space shall cease and the driver, possessor or person having control thereof shall be subject to the penalties as described in Section 2-505 each day for non-payment of overnight parking. The multi-space parking meter system shall be paid for and maintained by Durand Union Station, Inc. or its lawful assigns.

Section 74-108 - Lines and markings; manner of parking.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to install multi-space parking meters in spaces at Durand Union Station and to have lines or markings painted upon the curb, street or lot surface controlled by each parking space for which the meter is to be used. No person shall park any vehicle upon or across any such line or marking. The vehicle, insofar as possible, shall be centered within the designated parking space. The City Manager is hereby authorized to install numbered stall signs or stall numbers painted within the parking space to designate the stall number of the space.

Section 74-109 - Parking meters.

- (a) Overnight parking and meter activation required. Whenever a vehicle is parked within a designated parking meter space overnight, the operator of the vehicle shall activate the meter by depositing in the meter a United States currency of a denomination indicated on the parking meter legend, or using a credit card type accepted by the parking meter, or by activating the meter through the virtual account and if the meter is a manual type by turning or pressing the lever, handle, crank or other device provided upon such meter. Thereupon such parking space may be lawfully occupied by such vehicle during the period of parking time indicated on such meter, printed receipt or virtual paid duration.
- (b) *Civil infraction*. A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil infraction subject to the fine indicated in Section 2-505.

Section 74-110 - Parking meter damage.

No person shall:

- Deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any slug, device or metallic substitute for a United States currency; or
- (2) Remove, deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meter.
- (3) A person who violates section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 74-111 - Use of revenues.

All revenues derived from the use of parking meters as provided in this chapter shall be used to provide for the proper regulation and control of traffic of the Durand Union Station property, to cover the costs of developing and purchasing or leasing parking facilities, and to cover the costs of supervision, inspection, installation, operation,

maintenance, control and use of the parking spaces, lots, and meters; and the Durand Union Station facilities.

Section 74-112 - Collection from meters.

Collections of money deposited in parking meters shall be made as provided by direction of the City Treasurer.

Section 74-113 - Penalty.

- (a) Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter, for which no penalty is otherwise provided, is responsible for a civil infraction and shall be assessed a civil fine as provided for in Section 2-505 but in no instance shall the fine be less than \$50.00.
- (b) Whoever violates Section 74-110 is guilty of a misdemeanor and should be subject to the penalty provided in Section 1-16 of this Code of Ordinance.
