**Rules and Regulations**

Teams may consist of up to and no more than 5 players. All 5 players can play per night.

Random, per night subs will be allowed. These subs must pay \$5.00 per night sub fee, and must register as an active sub. Only registered subs will be considered as possible players in the season ending tournament.

There is a two player minimum to qualify as an active team. Less than two players will result in forfeiture for the team.

Substitutions can be made, but only after a scored point or during a time out.

First possession will be determined by one player shooting a "do or die" shot. Make it, that player's team's gets possession, miss and the opposing team gains possession.

Games are to 21 by two, or 25 by 1.

All baskets made inside the arch are worth one (1) point.

All baskets made outside the arch are worth two (2) points.

Games will begin promptly at 7:00 pm unless weather conditions delay the start. The League Director will make the call as to whether games will be canceled due to weather conditions. Teams who arrive later than 7:20 will forfeit the first game only. No shows will forfeit all games.

The League Director will have final say in all disputes. Competitive means for resolution will be considered, for example, a coin toss or a "do or die" shot may be called to determine ball possession.

Each team is allowed 3 – "1 minute time outs" per game. Time outs can only be called when that team has possession of the ball. Injury time outs are applied to the team of the injured player and will be called immediately.

In tie ups, if the defensive player calls "BALL" possession is turned over to the Defensive team.

Fouls will be called by the offensive player before the basket is scored. Fouls cannot be called after the shot is made. Fouls called before the shot nullify the points if the basket is scored, no continuations. Foul is the only term that can be used.


Ball must be taken behind the Arc on change of possession; Body and Ball.

Abusive Play or Language will not be tolerated. It is expected that each Team Captain will police their own teams. The League Director will issue one warning to the Captain. If the abusive language or play continues the Captain will be asked to bench the player for the remainder of the game, and if necessary remove them from the courts. If necessary, the League Director can disqualify the team for that game, the night, or the league depending on the severity of the situation. It is the Leagues wishes to conduct each game in a polite and professional manner, and to protect any young spectators from witnessing unfriendly competition. Complaints will be taken seriously.
